

THE ASSEMBLY OF SHIMER COLLEGE  
ACTS OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF APRIL 18, 2010



I Motion:

The resolution of no confidence from the meeting of February 28, 2010, is taken from the table.

The motion carried, after a vote by secret ballot, by 57 votes in favor, 3 opposed, and 1 abstention.  
The count of the ballots was witnessed by visitor Suzanne Sklar.

II Resolution (as amended):

Whereas the Presidency of Thomas Lindsay has imperiled the very existence of the College,  
the Assembly declares that it has no confidence in the ability of President Lindsay to lead Shimer  
College.

The resolution was adopted, after a vote by secret ballot, by 60 votes in favor, none opposed, and 3  
abstentions. The count of the ballots was witnessed by visitor Suzanne Sklar.

III Motion:

The Assembly instructs the Speaker to address and disseminate resolutions and motions adopted  
or passed on this day to all the constituencies of Shimer College, including Trustees and alumni.

The motion was passed unanimously.
